 - Anger management for ASD
 - Communication (ASD)
 - Functional behavior Analysis

Task Dimensions:

- Supports the transition process for students with autism, from school to community living. The ATF works under the direction of the Autism Consultant for the South Shore Regional School Board. For example:
 - The mobilization of resources to support the student in transitioning
 - Working cooperatively as a member of the school Program Planning Team
 - Regular Communication with the school staff, parent and community agencies
 - Assisting the teaching staff in the development of appropriate materials
 - Transporting student to home and community based programs
 - Administering of appropriate assessments for student with ASD
 - Reporting of assessment results to school team and making recommendations based on results
 - Provide training, support and professional development to school teams under the direction of the Autism Consultant.

- Performs other related duties as required.
